**The Emergency Assistance Center (TEAC) saw a surge of new clients seeking help who had never dreamed of asking for food assistance.** In addition, existing TEAC clients had setbacks. Their work hours were drastically reduced, they were laid off or their employer went out of business, or a parent had to stay home with school-aged children.

Amanda is a single parent and sole caregiver of her two children. **As the elementary school schedules changed from in-person to hybrid, then to remote learning, Amanda had no choice but to resign from her job.** She is currently looking for employment where she can work from home. Her search has taken much longer than expected and it is hard to make ends meet.
