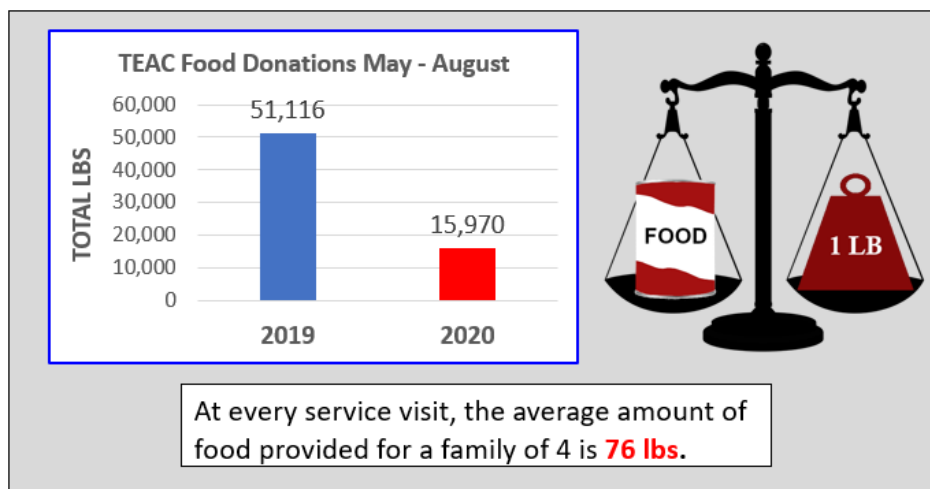

Hygiene bags typically contain toilet paper or paper towels, deodorant, shampoo or body wash, toothpaste and bar of soap.
